You can all help make a difference in the lives of children and their families.

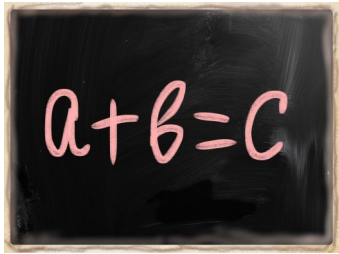

Our Program

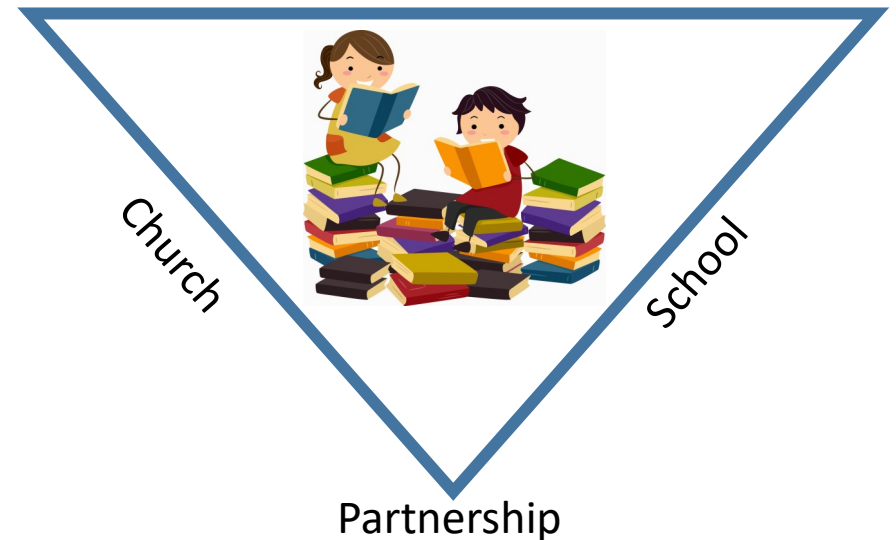
We provide one and one half hours of one-on-one tutoring.
